Bike Club

The concept – to provide learning opportunities for children and young people aged 10-20 and their families through cycling activities



Target

- At least 74 Bike Clubs in Scotland:
 - after-school clubs
 - community youth clubs
 - family projects
 - clubs working specifically supporting those under-represented in cycling including young people excluded from formal education, girls & young women; BME young people; disabled young people;

Youth Campaigning

- CTC projects just starting up:
 - Cycle Champions Project in Southport – young peoples cycling forum
 - Cardiff YMCA YDon'tU Forum – young people from communities, youth groups and schools across Cardiff. Meet 1/month to discuss cycling issues for them in Cardiff and invite local experts to share knowledge
