

## Pilot of on-street residential cycle parking

The City of Edinburgh Council is committed to increasing the percentage of all journeys in the city by bike to 10% by 2020. One of the biggest barriers to cycling in the city is a lack of suitable cycle parking for residents in tenement areas.

In recognition of this, the Council is considering providing on-street cycle parking in areas with tenement residences. This will initially be done on a trial basis at a small number of locations. We are planning to trial:

- covered cycle racks;
- individual lockers; and
- uncovered cycle racks.

## Examples of types of parking to be considered:



The pilot project will aim to evaluate the effectiveness of the different options and the potential for wider use. We aim to have the facilities available on a trial basis in time for summer 2012 with the trial then lasting around 2 years.

In order to identify the best locations for the pilot installations we are inviting residents to express an interest in participating in the scheme. For an application to be successful we are looking for evidence that there is demand for the parking. In addition, for the

covered parking options we are looking for commitment to help in managing the access to and maintenance of the facilities.

Due to the need to give priority to areas with the worst bike parking problems only the following are eligible:

- 1. Tenemental with no suitable alternative cycle parking
- 2. Other high density housing with no suitable cycle parking

Housing with accessible communal areas available to provide cycle parking will not be eligible.

Applications are subject to being selected on the basis of suitability and feasibility. We cannot guarantee that locations that are selected will be installed.
