North:

- 10 N. Edinburgh: 24 hrs waiting restrictions to be imposed on Russell Rd near Sauchiebank. Will improve exit from Rosebank path -
- 20 Waterfront: Planning Dept open first phase of Promenade. Complaints about surface & rubbish at West Gorton, but this part of next phase, which is only partially complete. -
- 89 Forth Bridge meet FBTA, close & for cyclists will move to east side arrangements not perfect but will be signed. FBTA want 3 monthly meetings & will do more for cyclists in medium term. AHS
- 120 Lower Gorton Rd, road works at for new road configuration. Issues will go ahead -
- 121 Planning Applications: appeal for City Park will proceed 16/6 -

South:

- 19 Midlothian Council: St Kentigern Way - centre of Penicuik to be 20mph zone. Important is on "A" road in town centre; should create precedent for other town centres. AHS
- Mayfield Place Mayfield propose 1 way: not direct as only short diversion needed -
- Leith Harbour railway to be closed for 8 weeks w.e.f 29/6 -

West:

- 300 Trams: Some track actually laid in Prince St. Phase 1b (Rosebank) not go ahead at present -
- 308 Steinhame: cycle paths very badly aligned. PH to take up. PH
- 309 Glenbrook Rd Balcarras; proposed 30mph limit - OK -

Central:

- 5 George IV Bridge: Member wrote about road layout for cyclists at new hotel. Met C3C (S Sanders) & got very good solution with short right turn lane for cars & cycle lane right up to junction (perhaps even coloured). (Base to design) AHS/MSJ

20 West Central Edinburgh: pay for new building near conference centre moves cycle racks to back. should be more racks & better sited

ANS

30 Potters new traffic lights allow cyclists to turn in all directions, but sequence now has delays: decided this is the price to pay

112 Fountain North: new proposed TLD shows 1 way road from Upper Guel Place to Braughfield St. good as not a through route. Ideally cyclists to use dual use pavements to go 2 way. Seems odd but logically leads to other shared ped / cycle areas.

S Saylor suggested cycle route next to W Park Rd (Tolbooth Square/Muir St) said Saylor wanted this for many years
