North

- 20. Waterfoot. PH looked at new promenade paths in West Granton area, are good but do not connect up because not all of phase 2 constructed. At eastern end should have short term little - Salford connection over of final path along coastline as development takes place over next 30 years. Some paths in Granton Waterfoot constructed but fenced off. A.R.
- 42. File: members complaining about lack of cycle parking, although good cycle routes in new Dunbar East housing; also needs connection to eg Ferrytoll. Suggests cycle forum, perhaps contact S. Kewler. A.S. 10/09
- 46. Carse Tolly CEC has plan for improving roundabout, not involving signalisation. Apparently will help cyclists but will have to look at; now not a cluster point for cycle routes. A.S.
- 89. Forty Bidge: guidance issued by gov in parliamentary process; will be a hybrid bill as response to architecture.
- 421. City Park planning appeal - seems fairly big - due to last 5 days.

South

- 19. Millthorpe Bush Farm Rd to have 20mph limit near Easter Bush, plus cycle path being constructed behind road. Bubs - Goringhale & Leicestershire to have extended 30mph limits as towns expand.
- 42. A68 Pathhead Tynehead - orders approach.
- 42. Grange/Prestonhill Gov Council passing several cycle themes like bridge over railway to help G.S. - KB route, at West Salford Terrace/Mayfield Rd junction due cycle routes. If road into S. Spokes; also raise with the Melrose? A.S. 10/09
- 31. R12 Little France really seems to be quiet - asking for improved cycle access. Crispin Hill Centre access to be improved says CEC & looking at further facilities on old Dalrymple Rd.
- 196. Maggathill: direct to go for one hour as will need extra traffic on lane now used by cyclists (09/08/09/FUL)

East

- 90 Chalky Square to be Edinburgh to first home zone
- 61 Meadbank new year for St Margaret's house site for hotel, studios etc only vehicles access from Sackby Lane; need map for cyclists for bus route (09/09/09) (09/09/09)

- 300 Trans Gogar Station PAN out; need path along to Gyle Gate to be for cyclists as well (09/09/09) in Gyle Gate (13/9)
- St Andrew Oil pipe remaining length of bus lane: or alternative cycle path
- 444 Rainton Main Rd path for dog park in garden centre site 'ohit'; in green belt (09/09/09) (09/09/09)

- 5 Prince St; will be consultation in Aug about permanent removal of buses. Submits wants joint approach but every body has slightly different angle
