

## Where can I cycle without traffic?

We have traffic-free cycle paths between Dalkeith (Edinburgh College) and Penicuik (Valleyfield Road) via Bonnyrigg (8 miles), and between Roslin (Manse Road) and Lasswade Road at its junction with Gilmerton Dykes Road, Edinburgh, via Straiton Pond and Loanhead (3.5 miles). See the diagram below for easy points at which you can join or leave the cycle paths. (Eskbank Station opens in September 2015).





National Cycle Routes 1 and 196 pass through Midlothian, connecting with East Lothian, Edinburgh, the Scottish Borders and the rest of the UK.
