You will probably be aware of the recent tragic death of Malaysian Edinburgh University medical student Zhi Min Soh at the West End junction.

The exact cause of Zhi Min Soh's crash is not known. Eyewitnesses and the press have stated it was caused by a wheel getting caught in the tramlines, but we have to await official reports before knowing for certain what happened and the full circumstances.

A one-minute silence in memory of Zhi Min Soh has been organised at the West End junction this <u>Wednesday 7 June at 8.30a.m.</u>. Anyone concerned is welcome to come, on foot or with bike. You can arrive at the junction itself, or meet at 8.15 at <u>West Register House</u> (Charlotte Square). The event is public and has already been previewed in the <u>Evening News</u>.

A <u>crowdfunder</u> has been set up to help with Zhi Min Soh's funeral costs.
