2. Make a Splash! - small grants for voluntary groups in Scotland, to encourage community participation in arts/crafts. Only relevant to ideas using community participation – not individual standalone artworks. www.peoplemakingwaves.org.uk/makeasplash/apply

3. Landfill sites – Katharine Taylor says “*the Communities Landfill Fund will provide grants for artworks, but they have to be within 10 miles of a landfill site. There are also several Sustrans construction projects in Scotland where we could incorporate some artwork - there are certainly possibilities which are worth discussing*” and “*The Community Landfill Fund can provide money for the **build and maintenance of cycling and walking paths, landscaping and artworks**. If you know of any suitable paths near any of these sites, it may be worth applying for funding.*”

The closing date for applications is the 10th November 2010, but the application process for projects under £2,000 will now be a rolling monthly decision process.
