- **Cycle on the left**



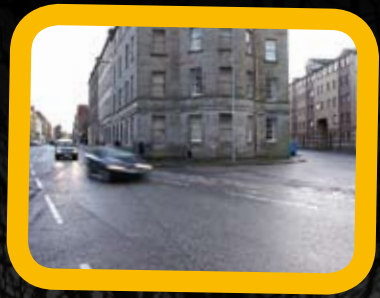
Cyclists mean busier paths, this can enhance feelings of safety at isolated places and times.
