

## A Fork in the Path

This visual pun has no historical or geographical significance, but is just for fun.

I think it would be amusing to have a giant image of a fork (eating kind) inlaid into the path surface where it would be seen by any cyclist approaching the fork (ie 'Y' junction) in the Roseburn Path at Craighleith, where the Blackhall Path branches off.

The fork image would have to be flush with the path surface, so it would be a flattened, plan view, but otherwise as realistic-looking as possible.

I'm assuming that using actual metal for the fork shape would be too dangerous, as this would be rather like multiple tram lines! Instead, I think a good effect could be achieved with some sort of ceramic mosaic.
