#### Smarter Choices: Smarter Places

Seven towns over three years

173,000 people

Walking, cycling and public transport

Budget of £15M over three years

90 schools

12,000 travel diaries

32 path improvements, 288 cycle parking installations

35% spend on cycling and walking

£8 per capita on promotion, £18 per capita on infrastructure



#### Sustrans I-Bike

I-Bike works in schools

5,000 young people directly involved

Building momentum, providing infrastructure

Transition from primary to secondary school

Focus on girls



### Cycling Scotland training

318 cycle trainers trained since 2008

40 more in 2010

98% of schools offered Scottish Cycle Training Scheme: 67% take up the offer

52% take up the offer of on-road training



#### Schools in 2010

15,000 children attend a cycle friendly school

80% of schools have a travel plan

134 schools will install new cycle parking

18 schools will receive funding from 'short links'
