

Edinburgh Tram Update

I refer to our previous communications concerning the forthcoming tram works. You will recall that our communication and the commencement of these works was dependant on a decision by the City of Edinburgh Council on the Tram project.

These discussions have taken place on the future of the tram project and works will now recommence in the following areas on these dates;

- Haymarket Phase 1 – Enabling works commencing 19th September with full works starting 3rd October 2011
- Balbirnie Place – Install traffic /pedestrian management 25th September with works commencing 26th September 2011
- Russell Road – Install traffic management and road closure 25th September with works commencing 26th September 2011
- Roseburn Street and Murrayfield – Install traffic management 18th September with works commencing 19th September 2011
- Baird Drive - including Water of Leith Bridge and Balgreen Road Bridge – Install traffic /pedestrian management including both east and west footpath closures 25th September with works commencing 26th September 2011
- Carrick Knowe Bridge and Guided Busway – Works commencing 26th September 2011
- South Gyle Access Bridge – Install traffic /pedestrian management 25th September with works commencing 26th September 2011
- Edinburgh Park Bridge - Works commencing 26th September 2011

The traffic and pedestrian management arrangements relevant to the works in your area will be installed over the weekend prior to the construction commencement dates.
