Cycle racks

In general we would like to see more racks on roads e.g. replacing car parking spaces instead of pedestrian space. This could either be achieved by putting bike parking on 'road space' or new build-outs into the road space depending on individual locations.

City Art Centre (there use to be two Sheffield racks but have recently been removed)
Darnaway Street / Wemyss Place (there are quite a few offices and residents don't like people leaving bikes on railings)
additional cycle racks in Rose Street, Stockbridge, George IV Bridge (near library) & Crichton Street as existing racks are always full
George Street
North end of Leith Walk
Along Leven Street / Bruntsfield Place (Corner of Barclay Terrace?)
Portobello Prom (kids' playground & near cafes/pubs)
former access to Calton Hill (near old Royal High School)
on top of Calton Hill - old turning circle
Constitution St post office
St Johns Road, Corstophine at Station Road
St Margaret's Park, Corstophine
London Road at Abbeyhill / Meadowbank
outside local libraries (e.g. MacDonald Road, Portobello, Dundee St)
Murrayfield Ice ring
Fort Kinnaird
