1. Musselburgh [and wider area] Sustainable & Active Travel Masterplan

- drop-in Thurs 3 May; final comments May 18

The Council is consulting on this 'masterplan' which, once approved, will form the basis for future funding applications to Sustrans and other funding sources to provide much improved conditions for getting about by non-car modes.

A couple of members who have had a quick look online say they are quite impressed by the proposals (e.g. see picture from the consultation) and it would be good for as many members as possible to support the overall proposals - as well as suggesting improvements.

Even if you don't live in Musselburgh, but visit the area, please do take part in the consultation.

Note that the consultation map covers a wide area, including connections to/from **Midlothian**, **Shawfair**, the Royal Infirmary and Cameron Toll.

2. East Lothian Local Transport Strategy - consultation ends May 10

Edinburgh Council is consulting on creating a toucan pedestrian/cycle crossing linking Moredunvale Road to Little France Drive and the Infirmary, together with upgrading associated paths.

If the consultation results are favourable, and subject to some land agreements, they hope to do the work in this financial year 2018/19.


