Apologies for another circular so soon after the <u>previous one</u> – we normally only send out email circulars 'roughly monthly.' However, Edinburgh Council has just announced the major event below for Clean Air Day, Thurs 21 June. It needs lots of public support, so please put in your diary and tell friends & colleagues.

We've also included a reminder of the <u>4 Spokes EdFoC events</u> – see section (2) overleaf – and see you there!!

#### 1. Clean Air Day, Edinburgh Council Events, Thursday 21 June

The Council has often been asked to follow the example of other cities in Europe and run traffic-free events on the City's streets. At last, they are doing so, on Thursday 21 June, which is Clean Air Day for <u>Scotland</u> and <u>UK</u>. **The Mound** and **North Hanover St** will be closed (except to walk/bike) 9.30-1.30 and the **east section of George Street** from 9.30am till midnight.

If the day goes well and is well supported, it will encourage the Council to do more – for example there has been talk of city centre (or wider) 'Cicolvia' Car Free Days now seen in cities across the world. Support will also encourage the Council to be bold in the City Centre Transformation project – again following other cities.

- ◆ 10:30 12:00 The Mound Hart's Cyclery E-bike and Cargo bike try-outs up The Mound
- ◆ 10:00 17:00 **Stalls** on George Street unfortunately Spokes didn't have the volunteer organisational capacity to have a stall here, but Sustrans and some other cycling bodies will be there
- ◆ 11:00 14:00 East George Street **Balance bikes try-outs** for pre-school kids and All-Ability Cycling **Adaptive bikes** from Edinburgh ABC.
- ◆ 12:00 22:00 Enjoy **relaxing in an urban garden space** in George Street while the children play. A new space to sit and relax with temporary landscaping and seating demonstrating the benefits of greening on placemaking and air quality. Bring your own picnic lunch.
- ◆ 12:00 17:00 East George Street **Challenges** for adults and children, to power lights and scalextric cars by pedal power
- ◆ Thurs a.m.; Thurs p.m.; Fri a.m. Indoor seminars, talks and workshops see page 2 of the <u>draft</u> <u>programme</u>. You need to book (free) for these events see the programme for email address. Spaces are limited, so you may not get a place.
