Proposed Gilmerton Crossroads Parking Restriction Scheme

Please be advised that as part of overall emergency measures we are proposing to introduce parking restrictions on the approaches to Gilmerton Crossroads. The measures proposed will ensure key parts of the road network are kept clear, prioritising public transport. The proposals have the aim of providing buses with reduced journey times and improved reliability, to ensure that services remain responsive to public health measures and reliable during the current Covid-19 pandemic

I have attached the proposed designs for the scheme. In summary it shows:

- Introduction of parking, waiting and loading restrictions on approaches.
- Refresh of existing bus stop clearway markings.
- Refresh of existing centre line.

Given the urgency to make the required changes any comments relating to these proposals should be received by **1200hrs on Monday 8 March** to <u>transport.publictransaccess@edinburgh.gov.uk</u>

All feedback will be reviewed and where possible the scheme will be further refined. Feedback will be summarised in an assessment feedback form which will be presented to the Council Incident Management Team for approval. Please note that we will be unable to respond to individual emails.

The introduction of, or changes to, any restrictions will be implemented under emergency delegated decision-making powers using a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order.
