Proposed A90 Bus Priority and Cycle Improvements Scheme

Dear Councillors and Stakeholders

Thank you for your comments regarding the proposed emergency road measures. Comments have been reviewed and are included in the attached assessment feedback form. Following consideration by [full Council](#) on 19 November 2020 the proposals were approved for implementation with the following changes having been agreed during and post installation:

- In direct response to resident's feedback, alterations were made during installation to the proposals being delivered between Queensferry Terrace and Orchard Road South.
- Following post installation feedback, safety related alterations were made to the carriageway adjacent to the now closed (east) Buckingham Terrace junction at Queensferry Road. This alteration also included the extension of the 20mph zone on Queensferry Road outbound to the Queensferry Terrace roundabout.

The measures have now been installed and officers are currently monitoring the temporary measures and will make adjustments as necessary to mitigate any impacts.
