Spokes will submit a more detailed written response. Some brief points to mention:

Cycling is to be given priority over general traffic so Bernard Street should have a traffic alternating traffic flow so that cycleways can be continuous. It is not clear that links towards Newhaven Tram Stop, Ocean Terminal, Ocean Quay (Scottish Government) actually reach those destinations - clearly they should!

it is our understanding that a new asphalt path is to be provided by the Trams to Newhaven project to link to the Hawthornevale Path - the illustration shows "existing asphalt path".

Uni-directional cycleways are generally our preference. Proposed widths are "minimal" in some places - clearly if these could be widened it would be beneficial in order to cater for increased cycling volumes and larger cargo bikes etc. Also, wider sections for passing should be provided where there is space.

The new "circulatory"-style cycle crossings at junctions don't seem to cater well for all movements. It is not clear, for example, how many times cyclists would have to stop in order to turn right. Cyclists may be tempted to contraflow via a more direct route.

Leaving and joining the cycleway at non-major junctions and to/from other routes needs to be catered for.

Construction timing would be good to know especially relating to the sections on the route from the Foot of the Walk to Ocean Terminal.
