David M's update:-

"Next steps for the SCIO transition, which I would welcome help with, are to identify the actual people who should be the first trustees. We need 'names in the frames' for everyone who will put their names on the application to OSCR.

I'd suggest this be a rep from each Group (Planning, Resources, Maps etc), and from any regional groups who will be part of the go-forward SCIO (so Porty, South Edinburgh etc). Also, ideally, Paul as Treasurer (or, if not Paul, someone who is willing to be Treasurer). This would give the new Trustees democratic legitimacy.

We don't strictly need a separate Chair and Secretary, as the Trustees elect these from amongst themselves. However I am happy to join as a Trustee and be Secretary if nobody else wants that role."
