## **Meadows to Union Canal project**

The City of Edinburgh Council has been working on proposals to improve walking, wheeling and cycling between the Meadows and the Union Canal, following the route of National Cycle Network 75 (NCN75). The project will also deliver other improvements in nearby public spaces along the route.

We would like to share an update with you on the latest progress of this project.

We have developed the designs with significant input from key stakeholders and the local community. [The most recent consultation was in 2019](#). As this was just before the COVID-19 pandemic, we had to pause the project until summer 2024. We are currently engaging with local businesses and key stakeholders with the latest proposals as we finalise the project's detailed designs.

To make the proposed changes, we will promote Traffic Regulation Orders (TROs) and Redetermination Orders. These are the legal processes needed to make changes to streets, such as parking, waiting and loading restrictions. We are planning for this to start in late 2025.
